# **RSL Alto Sax Graded Certificates – Technical Exercises Requirements**

For each grade, all exercises must be performed as indicated below, in the order shown, as set out in the relevant Grade Book.

Group A and B items should be performed to a click, commencing after a 4-click count-in. Group C should be performed without a click.

# Grade 1

### **Group A: Scales**

Tempo: ↓ = 50 Ascending and descending Each to be performed straight, using two articulations: (i) tongued and (ii) slurred (6 scales in all)

G major, 1 octave G dorian, 1 octave G minor pentatonic, 1 octave

#### **Group B: Arpeggios**

Tempo: J = 50 Ascending and descending Each to be performed straight, using two articulations: (i) tongued and (ii) slurred (4 arpeggios in all)

G major, 1 octave G minor, 1 octave

# Group A: Scales

Tempo: J = 55 Ascending and descending Each to be performed straight, using two articulations: (i) tongued and (ii) slurred (6 scales in all) D major, 2 octaves D dorian, 2 octaves D minor pentatonic, 2 octaves

### **Group B: Arpeggios**

Tempo: J = 55 Ascending and descending Each to be performed straight, using two articulations: (i) tongued and (ii) slurred (4 arpeggios in all)

D major, 2 octaves D minor, 2 octaves

# **Group B: Arpeggios**

Tempo: J = 60 Ascending and descending Each to be performed straight, using two articulations: (i) tongued and (ii) slurred (8 arpeggios in all)

Bb major, 1 octave A major, 1 octave Bb minor, 1 octave A minor, 1 octave

C major, 2 octaves G major, over a twelfth C dorian, over a twelfth G dorian, over a twelfth C minor pentatonic, 2 octaves G minor pentatonic, 2 octaves C mixolydian, 2 octaves C mixolydian, 2 octaves C blues, 2 octaves C chromatic, 2 octaves

#### **Group B: Arpeggios**

Tempo: J = 60 Ascending and descending Each to be performed straight using three articulations: (i) tongued, (ii) slurred, (iii) off-beat quaver swing tonguing (18 arpeggios in all)

D major 7th, 1 octave D minor 7th, 1 octave D dominant 7th, 1 octave G major 7th, 1 octave G minor 7th, 1 octave G dominant 7th, 1 octave

E major, 2 octaves F major, over a twelfth E dorian, 2 octaves F dorian, over a twelfth E mixolydian, 2 octaves F mixolydian, over a twelfth E minor pentatonic, 2 octaves F minor pentatonic, over a twelfth E blues, 2 octaves F blues, over a twelfth E chromatic, 2 octaves

# **Group B: Arpeggios**

Tempo: J = 70 Ascending and descending Each to be performed using three articulations: (i) tongued, (ii) slurred, (iii) off-beat quaver swing tonguing (24 arpeggios in all)

E major 7th, 2 octaves F major 7th, over a twelfth E minor 7th, 2 octaves F minor 7th, over a twelfth E dominant 7th, 2 octaves F dominant 7th, over a twelfth E diminished 7th, 2 octaves F diminished 7th, over a twelfth

G major, over a twelfth A major, over a twelfth D dorian, 2 octaves Bb dorian, 2 octaves D minor pentatonic, 2 octaves Bb minor pentatonic, 2 octaves D mixolydian, 2 octaves Bb mixolydian, 2 octaves Bb mixolydian, 2 octaves D blues, 2 octaves Bb blues, 2 octaves Bb blues, 2 octaves Bb chromatic, 2 octaves F# phrygian dominant, 1 octave D phrygian dominant, 1 octave G major exercise in broken thirds, over a twelfth

#### **Group B: Arpeggios**

Tempo: J = 80 Ascending and descending Each to be performed using three articulations: (i) tongued, (ii) slurred, (iii) off-beat quaver swing tonguing (15 arpeggios in all)

G major 7th, over a twelfth G minor 7th, over a twelfth G dominant 7th, over a twelfth D diminished 7th, 2 octaves Bb diminished 7th, 2 octaves

Ab major, over a twelfth C dorian, 2 octaves Eb dorian, 2 octaves B dorian, 2 octaves C minor pentatonic, 2 octaves Eb minor pentatonic, 2 octaves B minor pentatonic, 2 octaves C mixolydian, 2 octaves Eb mixolydian, 2 octaves B mixolydian, 2 octaves C blues, 2 octaves Eb blues, 2 octaves B blues, 2 octaves C chromatic, 2 octaves Eb chromatic, 2 octaves B chromatic, 2 octaves F phrygian dominant, 1 octave C phrygian dominant, 1 octave D major exercise in broken thirds, 2 octaves

Tempo: J = 100 Ascending and descending Each to be performed using three articulations: (i) tongued, (ii) slurred, (iii) off-beat quaver swing tonguing (15 arpeggios in all)

Ab major 7th, over a twelfth Ab minor 7th, over a twelfth Ab dominant 7th, over a twelfth C diminished 7th, 2 octaves B diminished 7th, 2 octaves

D major, over a twelfth Bb major, over a twelfth Eb major, over a twelfth F# dorian, over a twelfth C# minor pentatonic, 2 octaves E minor pentatonic, 2 octaves C# mixolydian, 2 octaves E mixolydian, 2 octaves C# blues, 2 octaves C# blues, 2 octaves E chromatic, 2 octaves E chromatic, 2 octaves C# phrygian dominant, 1 octave G# phrygian dominant, 1 octave Eb major exercise in broken thirds, 2 octaves

# **Group B: Arpeggios**

Tempo: J = 110Ascending and descending Each to be performed *twice* in contrasting articulations, using a roughly equal mixture of the following: (i) tongued, (ii) slurred, (iii) off-beat quaver swing tonguing (20 arpeggios in all)

D major 7th, over a twelfth Bb major 7th, over a twelfth Eb major 7th, over a twelfth D minor 7th, over a twelfth Bb minor 7th, over a twelfth Eb minor 7th, over a twelfth D dominant 7th, over a twelfth Bb dominant 7th, over a twelfth Eb dominant 7th, over a twelfth C# diminished 7th, 2 octaves
